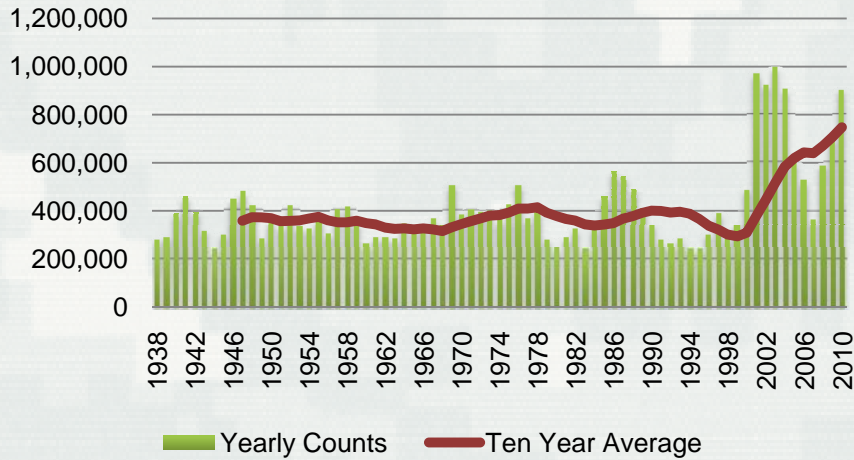


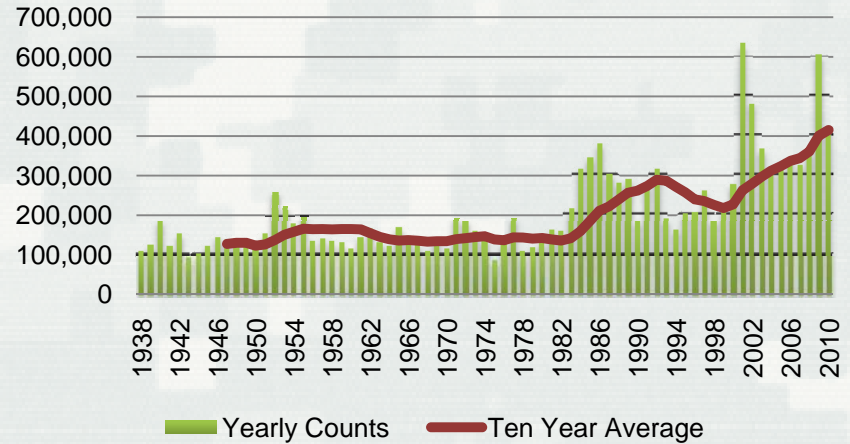

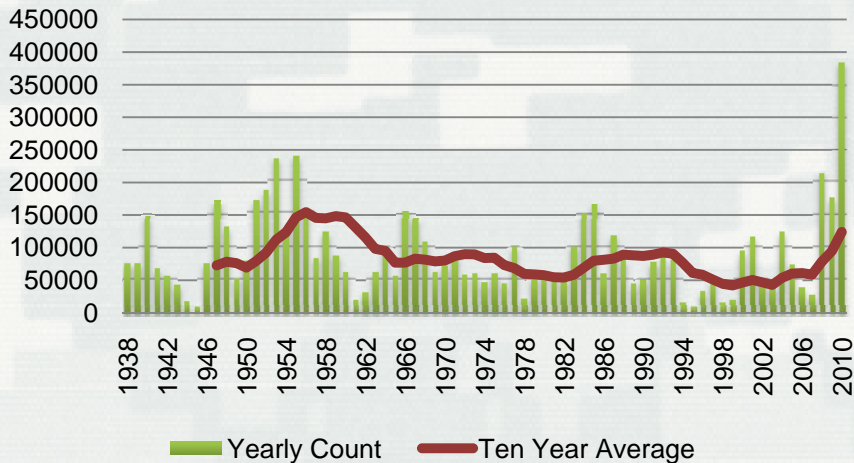
Fact: 2010 is within the top 5 largest chinook returns since BON construction in 1938.

Steelhead



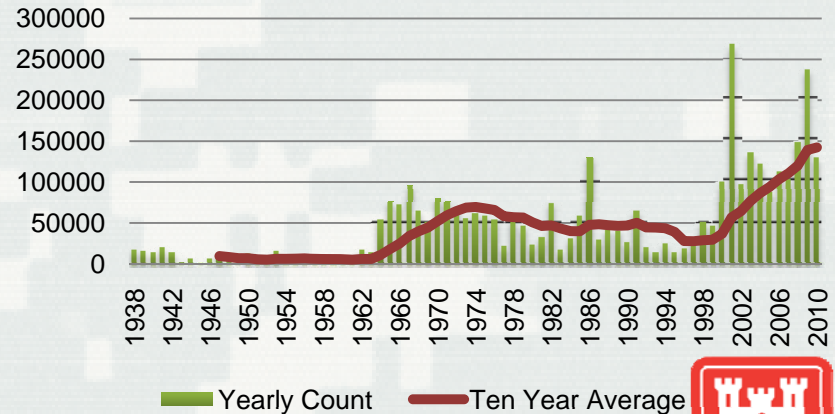
Fact: 2010 is the within the top 5 largest steelhead returns since BON construction in 1938.

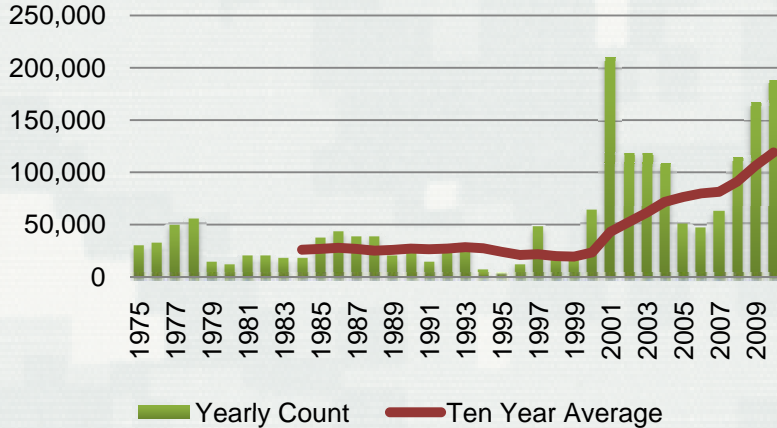


Fact: 2009 was the second largest coho return since BON construction in 1938.



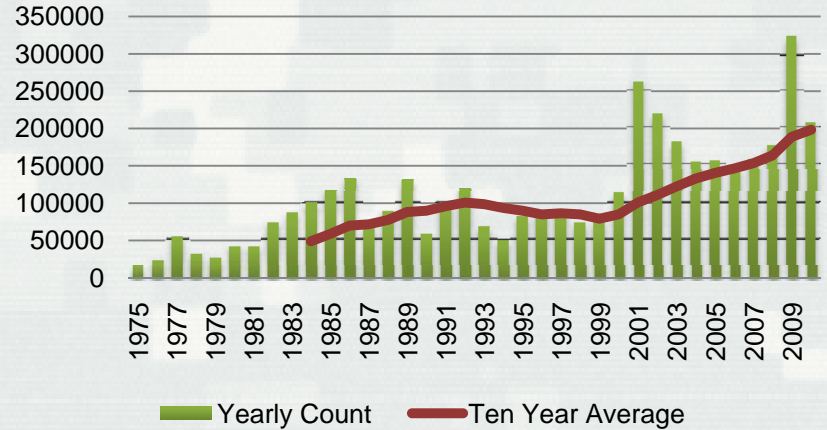

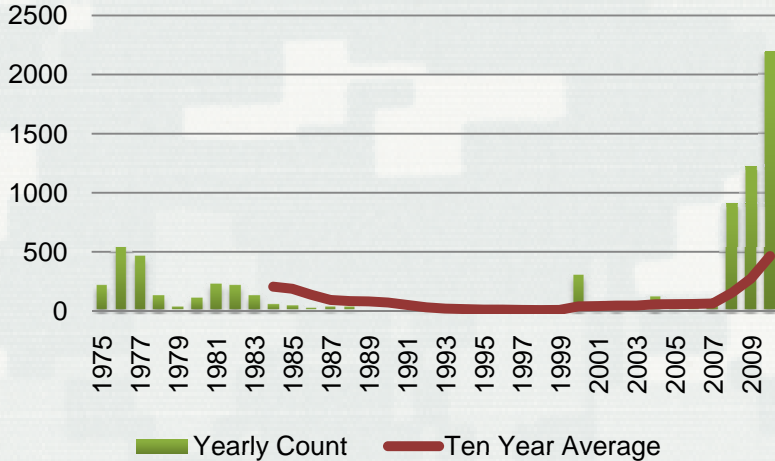

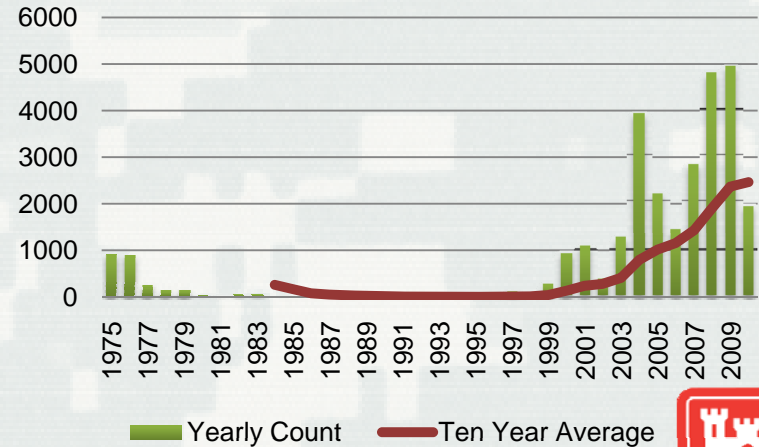

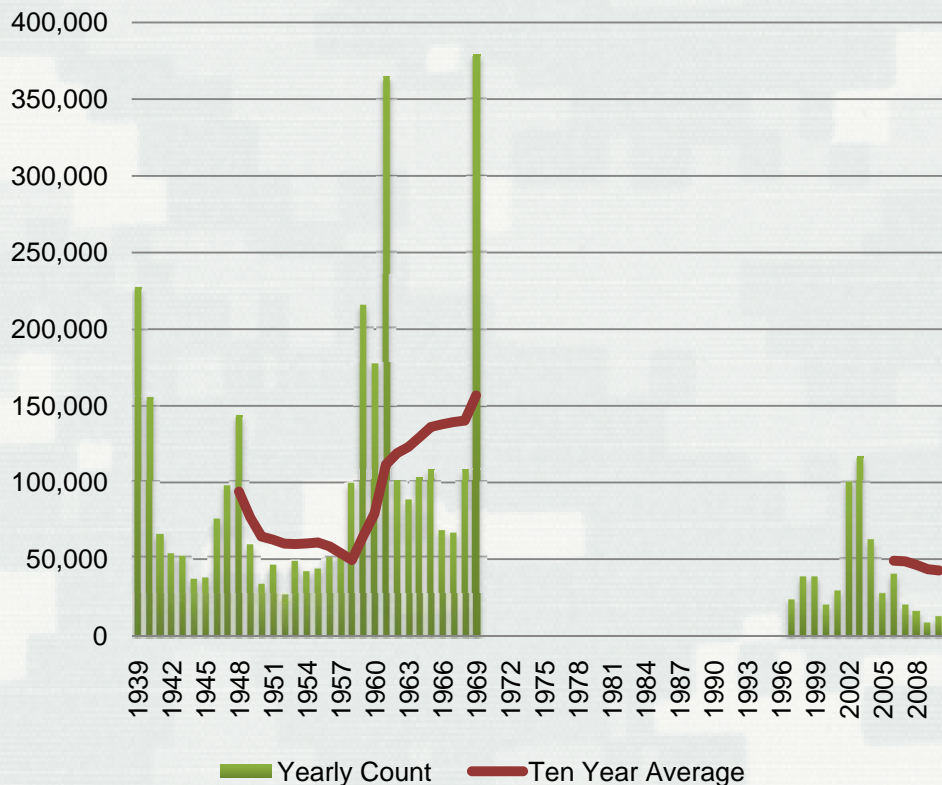


Fact: 2009 was the largest coho return since LGR construction.

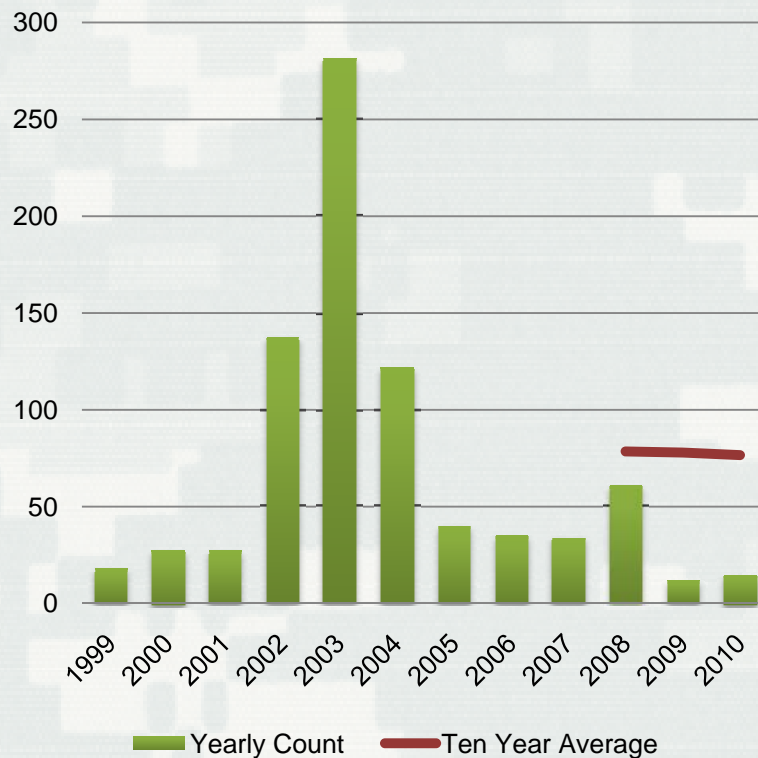
