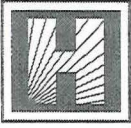

Dear Mr. Hall

Thank you for consulting with our office on the above referenced project. We understand the scope of work includes emergency repair of eight discontinuous locations on the Heise-Roberts Levee, totaling 3,850 linear feet of damage. Repair will be in-kind replacement resulting in a similar as constructed appearance. We disagree with the ineligibility determination for the levee. The Heise-Roberts Levee is eligible for the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) under Criterion A.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 800.5, we have applied the criteria of effect to the proposed undertaking. Based on the received 21 June 2018, we concur and find the proposed project actions will have **no adverse effect** to historic properties.

In the event that cultural material is inadvertently encountered during the implementation of this project, work shall be halted in the vicinity of the finds until they can be inspected and assessed by the appropriate consulting parties.
