

## FY03 DWORSHAK GRANTS

### Waterways Grant

# 212

Idaho State Parks Waterways Grant was approved for Dworshak. The grant is for the purchase of the additional items (anchors, cables, ladders, etc.) needed for the new destination docks and to complete a changeover to wider courtesy docks at Big Eddy, Bruce's Eddy and Dent. The majority of the new dock sections were purchased in late FY02 using O&M funds as well as some funds from an FY02 grant. These docks were purchased using Work Item F41KHB (Dworshak Tie Off Docks), Funding Accounts G436801 and G439819. The FY03 Grant paperwork has been signed and returned to the State of Idaho along with a request for a cash advance of funds. The grant funds will be available after 1 Jul 03 (beginning of State of Idaho fiscal year).

FY03 Grant Total: \$36,541.00  
COE Match: 15,430.00 (\$9010.00 cash and \$6420.00 in kind)

**Actions necessary:** Will need to transfer \$15430.00 into O&M funding account for Work Item F41KHB from 001T9H (DWA Recreation) to cover the Corps Match (\$9010.00 for parts and \$6420.00 for labor). Grants funds will be programmed into the cost share funding account for Work Item F41KHB once they are received from the State. NOTE: Walla Walla District Planning Division has already accomplished significant work on this project. Labor corrections will need to be accomplished once funding is moved into F41KHB to reflect the actual labor to date. These corrections may total the \$6420.00 labor match.

### Boating Infrastructure Grant (B.I.G)

The federal B.I.G. grant program was created in 1998 to provide funding to states for building transient facilities and enhance recreation opportunities for owners of boats 26 feet and larger.

**Purpose of FY03 Grant:** Purchase and install safe harbor docks along the reservoir for large boats. The original funding for the grant is Federal (U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service). The funding is then given to the Idaho State Department of Parks and Recreation for administration. Local sponsors match this grant funding. The Corps of Engineers is also a grant sponsor as well as the property owner. The Corps will supply in-kind services of procurement and installation of the docks. The local sponsor has already raised \$15786.00. The Clearwater County Treasurer is currently holding this funding. They would like to give this funding to the Corps right away so it can be removed from their financial records. The Grant has been awarded to the Corps of Engineers but the Fish and Wildlife Service will not release funds to the State of Idaho until the project has been cleared through environmental review. The Walla Walla District Planning

Division is currently accomplishing this review and clearance is anticipated within a month.

**Actions necessary:** Need to create a work item with two funding accounts (one for O&M funds to be used for installation of the docks and one for the grant funding – both from the local sponsor and the State of Idaho).
