2015 Annual Maintenance Outage Update

The Snake River Locks will begin taking the locks out of service 6 March at 11 a.m. Because of the gate cable failure at Goose and commercial traffic clearing the system, this allows the locks to begin preparations for maintenance. Maintenance, inspection and repair work will take place at the locks during the closure.

Locks to be closed include McNary Lock & Dam, (CO river mile 292); Ice Harbor Lock & Dam, (SN river mile 9.7); Lower Monumental Lock & Dam, (SN river mile 41.6); Little Goose Lock & Dam, (SN river mile 70.3); and Lower Granite Lock & Dam; (SN river mile 107.3). Please note in the table below that all locks will be out of service for four-weeks in order to complete maintenance and repairs.

The Projects have scheduled routine inspections and maintenance, as well as some non-routine work. The non-routine work includes gate structural repairs, machinery replacement, lock structure repairs.

This is a Columbia/Snake River System outage coordinated with Portland District.
