




Waters of Idaho Regulated Under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899




1. Bear Lake - That portion within the State of Idaho
2. Clark Fork River - from the mouth upstream to River Mile 4.0
3. Clearwater River - from the confluence with the Snake River upstream to River Mile 40.5 (mouth of the North Fork Clearwater River)
4. North Fork Clearwater River - from the confluence with the Clearwater River including Dworshak Reservoir upstream to River Mile 57.9
5. Kootenai River - from Bonners Ferry to the Canadian border
6. Pack River - from the mouth upstream to River Mile 1.5
7. Lake Pend Oreille - from Albeni Falls Dam to elevation 2062.5 NGVD
8. Pend Oreille River - from the ID-WA border upstream to Albeni Falls dam
9. Snake River - from the ID-WA border upstream to River Mile 445.5
