To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to urge you to remove the four dams on the Snake River since the Columbia/Snake River system is so important to the continued flourishing of wild salmon. I have become aware that the four dams on the Snake River provide no flood control and only 5% of the area's electricity. The electricity providers are quoted as saying that this could easily be supplied in another fashion. As you are well aware, both The National Marine Fisheries Service and the US Army Corps of Engineers have released reports on the benefits of removing the dams. For me there is no question. The dams should be removed as soon as possible since due to the presence of dams during the past 25 years, 90% of the former number of salmon have perished, only 10% of the wild salmon remain.
