

RESOLUTION 00-4

A resolution of the City Council for the City of Kupreanof, Alaska, opposing cutbacks in the commercial harvest of Chinook salmon in the waters of Southeast Alaska.

WHEREAS the Federal Caucus Draft Feasibility Report/Environmental Impact Statement contains alternatives which result in cutbacks to the commercial harvest of Chinook salmon in the waters of Southeast Alaska, and

WHEREAS the State of Alaska has implemented numerous conservation measures over the last 20 years pertaining to commercial harvest of Chinook salmon, and

WHEREAS the State of Alaska has managed its salmon resources in an environmentally responsible and biologically sustainable manner, and

WHEREAS the commercial harvest in Southeast Alaska does not significantly impact the Snake River Chinook population, and


WHEREAS the State of Washington has allowed massive disruption of habitat through the building of dams, the polluting of waters, and extensive watershed disturbances imperiling many different runs of salmon,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Kupreanof opposes any alternatives which include cutbacks in the commercial harvest of Chinook salmon upon which our residents depend for their livelihood for subsistence and personal use.
