name: To the Federal Caucus and the Army Corps of Engineers, Extinction of Snake River salmon and steelhead is not an option. The vast majority of scientists say breaching the lower Snake River dams must be part of any successful recovery plan. Economic studies show dam removal is affordable and the least expensive option on the table.

I support Alternative 4 in the Corps, DEIS because it is the surest way to save Snake River salmon from extinction. Any plan to recover salmon basin wide under the All-H paper must also include dam removal on the lower Snake River.

I support breaching dams provided that southern Idaho water is protected in return and we provide measures for those negatively affected. A recovery plan must include investing in communities impacted by dam removal. We should offset increased shipping costs with taxpayer investment in rail and highway infrastructure.

Please consider this my formal comment on the All-H paper and the Corps, on the Lower Snake River Study.
