Ice Harbor Navigation Lock Gate Repair Update No. 3

Phase I of the repair work on Ice Harbor upstream lock gate was successfully completed on 10 November. The lock was reopened to commercial traffic only at 1800 on that date.

Wind continues to create problems with the floating bulkhead lockages. When the wind is approximately 15 mph or more, the floating bulkhead lockages must stop because of safety concerns. We appreciate your patience.

Phase II of the gate repair will begin **28 November, at 0001, and continue through 3 December, at 1700.** During this time the contractor will field assembly and weld the replacement gate pieces in place. **Ice Harbor Lock will be closed to all traffic, 24 hours a day, until this work is completed.**

All recreational craft lockages remain cancelled until the upstream gate is fully repaired and returned to service. (We appreciate your cooperation and understanding during this unplanned event.)

Commercial lockages will continue to be conducted as detailed below until Phase II of the repair work begins. Commercial lockages will be available 20 hours per day. Between the hours of 0200 and 0600 there will be **no lockages.**
