Navigation Lock outage at Little Goose Dam extended for additional gate repair

Update for March 26

Little Goose lockages using the floating bulkhead are further delayed and are tentatively planned to begin Friday March 30 at 1800hr once the upstream gate is stowed in a secure position.

Knight Construction working in concert with the Corps of Engineers determined that a second large crane is necessary to move the gate. A crane with the right capacity and characteristics for Little Goose was located today (Monday) and will be on site Wednesday.

All recreational craft lockages are cancelled until the lock returns to full service.

There will be at least two other lock closures in April during the repair process, with times and dates to be determined. Little Goose lock is expected to return to full service on or about May 1, as soon as possible.

Updates will be provided as repair work progresses.

Walla Walla District's other locks are operational with normal service.
