Little Goose Navigation Lock Update # 12

Three-Day Lock Closure Scheduled for Continuing Repair Work on Little Goose Upstream Gate

Repair work on the upstream gate at Little Goose Lock and Dam, located at Snake River mile 70.3 continues on schedule.

At this time, one, three-day, 24-hours per day, lock closure is necessary to complete the work. This closure will begin 7:00 a.m., Friday, April 13. The lock is scheduled to return to interim bulkhead lockage during evening hours, for commercial vessels only, Monday, April 16, at 7:00 p.m. The interim schedule will remain in place until the repairs are completed around May 1.

Friday Evening, April 13 – No lockage

Saturday Evening, April 14 – No lockage

Sunday Evening, April 15 – No lockage

Monday Evening, April 16 – 7:00 p.m. interim bulkhead lockage times in effect until repairs are completed.

All recreational craft lockages are cancelled until the lock returns to full service.

During the interim floating bulkhead lockage for commercial vessels the first lockage of the evening will take place at 7:00 p.m., downstream, with the last downstream lockage at 4:00 a.m. and the last upstream lockage at 5:00 a.m. **The floating bulkhead must be in place for Knight Construction to begin their work at 7:00 a.m. All lockages must be completed before the 7:00 a.m. repair work schedule begins each day.**

Updates will be provided as repair work progresses.
