## State grant requested to improve Dent Acres

**Orofino, Idaho** –The Walla Walla District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is always seeking ways to improve the recreation experience for visitors to its recreational facilities, such as nearby Dworshak Dam and Reservoir, according to a natural resources program recreation official.

“One of the things we want to improve for our visitors, for example, is the electrical system at the Dent Acres campground, roughly halfway up our 54-mile-long reservoir,” said Park Ranger Terry Bowden. “To do that, we’re applying to the Idaho Parks and Recreation Department for a grant under one of their programs for recreation programs here in the state.”

If the Corps’ application is approved by the state, work would be tentatively scheduled to begin in September 2004.

“Something as important to our recreation program is certainly something we’d also want to get comments from the public and we would want a chance to answer any questions folks might have,” said Bowden.
