## Corps resumes recreational lockages at Little Goose Dam

**Walla Walla, Wash.** – Recreational lockages for fishermen and other recreational vessels will resume tomorrow morning (Saturday, April 17) at Little Goose Lock and Dam, near Starbuck, Wash., according to a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers official.

“Our maintenance crews have finished making temporary repairs to the excess water passing through seal joints of the lock,” said Scott Ross, the operations manager at Little Goose. “This means we’ll be able resume the recreational lockages just in time for people to take advantage of the salmon fishing season announced by Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife.”

Recreational lockages for vessels heading upstream will be at 8 a.m., 11 a.m., and 3 p.m. Vessels heading downstream will be locked through at 8:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m., and 3:30 p.m.

Permanent repairs to the seals will be done at a time to be determined later. The Corps will announce those repairs to the public when the information becomes available.
