Orofino, Idaho – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers invites the public to participate in a working group to examine land-based recreation facilities. The group will hold its first meeting at 6 p.m. Sept. 13 at the Idaho Fish and Game building in Myrtle, Idaho.

In 2001 the Corps initiated three public input working groups to examine land access, water access and land management issues at Dworshak. These groups have nearly completed their work. However, none have covered land-based recreation development issues. Hence we are starting this new group.

“The public, partner agencies and Corps staff involved in these groups worked extremely hard to get through a lot of very difficult issues to develop recommendations for inclusion in the master planning process, and I would like to thank them for their time, energy and effort,” said Natural Resources Manager Paul Pence.
