Lyons Ferry Park to temporarily close June 15-16

STARBUCK, Wash., -- Lyons Ferry Park, located at Snake River Mile 59.5, will be closed to the public June 15-16, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers officials announced today. The park will reopen to the public on June 17.

Other Corps parks and boat ramps are open nearby. The following recreation facilities are listed in order of distance (river miles) from Lyons Ferry Park (list is limited to facilities within 25 miles of Lyons Ferry Park).

Lyons Ferry Marina Operator: Port of Columbia	Offers full-service camping, marina, boat launch, restrooms, showers, and a day-use area.	Located at Snake River Mile 59 on the south shore.
Ayer Boat Basin Operator: Walla Walla District	Offers camping, boat launch, vault toilets, and a day-use area.	Located at Snake River Mile 51 on the south shore.
Texas Rapids Operator: Walla Walla District	Offers camping boat launch, restrooms and a day-use area.	Located at Snake River Mile 66 on the south shore.
Riparia Operator: Walla Walla District	Offers camping, small-boat launch, vault toilets, and a day-use area.	Located at Snake River Mile 67 on the north shore.
Little Goose Landing Operator: Walla Walla District	Offers camping, boat launch, vault toilets, and a day-use area.	Located at Snake River Mile 72 on the south shore.
Devils Bench Operator: Walla Walla District	Offers camping, boat launch, vault toilets, and a day-use area.	Located at Snake River Mile 42 on the north shore.
Windust Park Operator: Walla Walla District	Offers camping, boat launch, vault toilets, and a day-use area.	Located at Snake River Mile 39 on the north shore.
Garfield Landing Owner/Operator: Port of Garfield	Offers a boat launch.	Located at Snake River Mile 82 on the south shore.
Central Ferry Park Operator: Northwest Land Management	Offers camping, boat launch, vault toilets, and a day-use area.	Located at Snake River Mile 83 on the north shore.
