Corps reviews permit application; *Permit requested from Bonner County, Idaho*

WALLA WALLA, Wash. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is reviewing an application requesting a Department of the Army permit for certain work in waters of the United States. The public notice regarding the permit application listed here was issued during the week of June 23, 2006.

Public Notice 061100057 provides information about a permit requested by the Beyond Hope Resort to repair, maintain and improve an existing marina facility. The project is located in the Pend Oreille Lake, south of East Hope, Bonner County, Idaho. Comments must be received by July 14, 2006. The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public, federal, state and local agencies, Native American tribes and other interested parties on these permit requests.

The Corps issues or denies permits for the discharge of dredged or fill material into U.S. waters under authority of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and for work in or affecting navigable waters of the United States under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899.
