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Corps reviews permit application *Permit requested from Valley County, Idaho*

WALLA WALLA, Wash. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is reviewing an application requesting a Department of the Army permit for certain work in waters of the United States. The public notice regarding the permit application listed here was issued July 24, 2006.

Public Notice 062100091, requested by Anthony and Tracey Garner, proposes a discharge of 800 cubic yards of native fill to grade the slopes of the existing man-made recessed boat channel and move the channel further to the east to provide safety for the applicant's children. The project is located in the Boulder Creek Embayment of Cascade Reservoir, Valley County, Idaho. Comments must be received by Aug. 14, 2006. The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public, federal, state and local agencies, Native American tribes and other interested parties on these permit requests.

The Corps issues or denies permits for the discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States under authority of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and for work in or affecting navigable waters of the U.S. under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899.
