Corps reviews permit application ***Permit requested from Bonner County, Idaho***

WALLA WALLA, Wash. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is reviewing an application requesting a Department of the Army permit for certain work in waters of the United States. The public notice regarding the permit application listed here was issued during the week of Sept. 24-30, 2006.

Public Notice 061200086, requested by Dover Bay Development, Inc., proposes a discharge of approximately 600 cubic yards of sandy gravel and 50 cubic yards of rock riprap waterward of the ordinary high water mark to reclaim an upland area that was previously excavated and establish a green space area. The applicant states he would construct a boardwalk paralleling the shoreline for public use.

The project is located along the Pend Oreille River in Bonner County, Idaho. Comments must be received by Oct. 17, 2006. A copy of the public notice may be found at www.nww.usace.army.mil/html/offices/op/rf/pn/061200086.pdf.

The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public, federal, state and local agencies, Native American tribes and other interested parties on these permit requests.

The Corps issues or denies permits for the discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States under authority of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and for work in or affecting navigable waters of the U.S. under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899.
