## Mudslide closes access across Lower Granite Dam

**WALLA WALLA, Wash.** – A mudslide that occurred today on Casey Creek road has closed public access across Lower Granite Dam.

The washout happened this morning around 10 a.m. on the Garfield County (south) side of the dam. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers officials have notified Garfield County of the road washout and workers are attempting to clear the debris from the road. However, it appears that public access across the dam will be delayed for the next 48 hours. The public will be notified when the access road across the dam reopens.
