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Road work to temporarily close access across Lucky Peak Dam

BOISE, Idaho – The access road across Lucky Peak Dam will be closed on Tuesday, March 6, from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. to allow maintenance workers to repair a culvert running under the road, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers officials at Luck Peak announced today.

There will be no road access to Barclay Bay, Turner Gulch or Foote Park recreation areas. Current water levels allow for boat access to the Lucky Peak Lake by using the boat ramp at Spring Shores Marina.

Visitors are encouraged to use the recreation facilities at Macks Creek and Robie Creek, as access to these areas will not be affected by the temporary road closure. However, park rangers remind boaters that lake levels are still too low to allow boat launching at those sites.
