## **Little Goose Lock and Dam closed to public vehicle crossings**

**STARBUCK, Wash.** – U.S. Army Corps of Engineers officials have temporarily suspended public vehicle crossings at Little Goose Lock and Dam until further notice.

To facilitate safe working conditions while repairs are being made to the dam's upstream navigation lock gate, Walla Walla District officials are limiting the number of vehicles allowed on top of the dam to only those which are essential to dam operations – this applies to both Corps and non-Corps vehicles.

As progress continues on repairing the lock gate, the District will reevaluate opening the dam for public crossings and other Corps vehicle traffic.

The Corps will distribute a news release to media when the access road across the dam reopens to public vehicle crossings. For the most up-to-date public crossing information for dams in the Walla Walla District, call 1-888-DAM-INFO (326-4636).
