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Repair work at Little Goose Lock and Dam will limit auto crossings

WALLA WALLA, Wash. – Private vehicle crossings will not be possible at Little Goose Lock and Dam, located at Snake River mile 70.3, from 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 3, to approximately 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 8, according to U.S. Army Corps of Engineers officials at the Walla Walla District.

The closure is necessary to repair an electronic system that raises and lowers the upstream road traffic access bridge. During this closure, the upstream access bridge will remain in the raised position, and cannot be lowered to permit vehicle passage across the dam. As previously announced this date, per New Release 07-39, the navigation lock at Little Goose Lock and Dam will be closed six hours from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., on Thursday, May 3 only, for repair work related to the work on the upstream traffic access bridge.
