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## **Corps reviews permit application**

### ***Permit requested from Bannock County, Idaho***

**WALLA WALLA, Wash.** – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is reviewing an application requesting a Department of the Army permit for certain work in waters of the United States. The public notice regarding the permit application listed here was issued July 9, 2007.

Public Notice 2007-561-I01, requested by Glade H. Davis, proposes to retain fill material discharged into approximately 0.1 acre of Marsh Creek and adjacent wetlands to construct a permanent access road to a peat extraction site. The applicant proposes to temporarily discharge dredged and fill material into 0.5 acre of wetland to stockpile overburden and peat material during excavation of peat. The applicant also proposes to temporarily discharge material into 0.5 acre wetlands to construct temporary access roads and work pads. The project is located in Marsh Creek and adjacent wetlands, in Bannock County, Idaho. Comments must be received by Aug. 14, 2006. The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public, federal, state and local agencies, Native American tribes and other interested parties on these permit requests.

The Corps issues or denies permits for the discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States under authority of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and for work in or affecting navigable waters of the U.S. under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899.
