Dworshak applies for state recreation grants

AHSAHKA, Idaho – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Dworshak Dam and Reservoir is applying for two 2009 grants from the Idaho Parks and Recreation Department.

One is for the purchase and installation of a new finger dock for Dent Acres Boat Ramp. Under this grant request, a dock for the temporary mooring of watercraft will be purchased to replace the current deteriorated dock. The new finger dock would provide a safer recreating environment and allow more efficient loading, unloading and mooring of boats with a reliable, safe and stable facility.

The other grant request is for a new destination dock for the upper reservoir area. This project would increase opportunities for current and potential new recreational boaters. The additional destination dock will provide a safer location for swimming on the reservoir and reduce the risk of boater and swimmer accidents or fatalities.
