## **Dworshak discharge flow increases March 30; use caution**

**WALLA WALLA, Wash.** – Water discharge from Dworshak Dam near Orofino, Idaho shall temporarily increase starting at 9:00 p.m., on Sunday, March 30, for flood control, US. Army Corps of Engineers operations officials announced today.

Discharge flow will be increased from approximately 8,400 CFS (cubic feet per second) to 10,700 CFS beginning at 9:00 p.m. on March 30 and will be maintained until further notice.

Corps officials advise boaters and other persons using water ways both in Dworshak Reservoir and below the dam on the Clearwater River to be alert to changes in water elevation and volume of flow during this time period.
