## Corps reviews permit application for residential development near Garden City

**WALLA WALLA, Wash.** – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is reviewing an application requesting a Department of the Army permit for certain work in waters of the United States. The public notice regarding the permit application listed here was issued Aug. 15, 2008.

Public Notice 052100186, requested by Dynamis Group, LP, proposes to discharge fill material into the South Fork Payette River and adjacent wetlands, Charters Creek and adjacent wetlands, Coski Creek and adjacent wetlands, three unnamed streams and adjacent wetlands. The applicant intends to construct residential roads and lots for the proposed Southfork Landing Subdivision, which is located near Garden Valley, in Boise County, Idaho. Comments must be received by Sept. 5, 2008. The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public, federal, state and local agencies, Native American tribes and other interested parties on these permit requests.

The Corps issues or denies permits for the discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States under authority of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and for work in or affecting navigable waters of the U.S. under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899.
