Media invited to learn more about interim risk reduction measures to improve public safety at Mill Creek Storage Dam

MEDIA ADVISORY: On Wednesday, Nov. 5, at 11 a.m., news outlets are invited to attend a briefing to help them better understand what the Corps is doing to improve public safety at the Mill Creek Storage Dam, near Walla Walla, Wash. Walla Walla District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, public affairs personnel will meet media representatives at 10:30 a.m. at the security station just inside the 3rd Avenue entrance of the district headquarters building in Walla Walla to begin required security inspections.
