

**RESERVOIR ELEVATIONS AS OF 0800:**

**LOWER GRANITE FOREBAY - 727.18      LOWER GRANITE TAILRACE - 633.6**

**AVERAGE INFLOW OVER LAST 24 HOURS:** 33.6 (forecast of 25.9 by 10th)

**DAILY FISH COUNT:** 38 (was 34 on 1 March, 43 on 2 March)

**MONITORING ACTIVITIES ACCOMPLISHED IN LAST 24 HOURS, AND RESULTS:**

1. Lower Granite gatewell dipping - 9 gatewells (units 3, 4 and 5):

- 17 O. nerka (i.e. - kokanee/sockeye = sockanee?)
- 42 chinook
- 23 hatchery steelhead
- 38 wild steelhead (majority were NOT smolted)
- 6 adult steelhead
- 2 carp
- 2 squawfish
- several miscellaneous

2. Began benthic monitoring. Mussel beds have been exposed. Idaho Dept. of Health and Welfare has issued warning to local folks to not eat them...

3. Survey in upper Lower Granite pool for fall chinook redds (results not in yet, although since I wasn't called last night, I expect nothing was seen).

4. Wildlife survey. Nothing to report.

5. Archaeological monitoring initiated. Nothing to report.

**MONITORING ACTIVITIES PLANNED TODAY:**

1. Continue benthic, fall chinook, wildlife and archaeological monitoring.

2. Sturgeon and squawfish monitoring efforts begin tonight.

**OTHER:**

No major problems noted; minor sloughing of embankments appears to have stabilized. Very localized increases in turbidity. Some juvenile resident fish have been lost in certain areas. Today, Washington Department of Wildlife is beginning rescue efforts for fish trapped in ponds behind the embankments on Lower Granite reservoir. No species composition for the ponds at this point in time. Some fish kill is anticipated due to the inability of personnel to retrieve fish from those ponds containing thick layers of mud. Not all ponds will drain completely however, so the extent of fish loss is not predictable.

**RESERVOIR ELEVATIONS AS OF 0800:**

**LOWER GRANITE FOREBAY - 725.18      LOWER GRANITE TAILRACE - 634.6**

**AVERAGE INFLOW OVER LAST 24 HOURS:** 29.9, discharge 39.6

**DAILY ADULT FISH COUNT:** 14 steelhead. Emergency system apparently functioning, although spot-checks have not resulted in seeing fish pass into the pipe (turbulence may prevent such an observation anyway...). Head on ladder weirs is less than 1 foot, but the rest of the collection system is functioning normally given the low tailwater elevation (yesterday was at very bottom - 633) - i.e. south shore and collection channel okay, north powerhouse and north shore entrance depths lower than desired. (We will try to check again today to see how it looks now that the tailrace is rising.)

**TURBINE OPERATION:** Two units (3 and 4) running steady. Third unit (5) on-line as needed to draft reservoir. No problems noted during testing efforts.

**MONITORING ACTIVITIES ACCOMPLISHED IN LAST 24 HOURS, AND RESULTS:**

1. Lower Granite reservoir sturgeon monitoring.
2. Squawfish tagging initiated.
3. Embankment ponds were checked for trapped fish. At this point, fish appear to be exiting ponds with the water flow. No rescue efforts needed by Washington Dept. of Wildlife as of yet - they will continue to monitor and we are in daily contact.

4. Localized increases in turbidity. Rain from several days ago resulted in increased turbidity that has now passed through the system. (Equipment troubles prevented documenting this phenomenon.)

**MONITORING ACTIVITIES PLANNED TODAY:**

1. Lower Granite gatewell dipping.
2. Continue wildlife, archaeological, resident fish, and squawfish, and turbidity monitoring activities.

**OTHER:**

Slumping of embankments occurring in Port of Wilma area. Other "minor" non-Federal problems that are being evaluated. Will keep you posted.


