

STATUS AS OF 30 JUNE

Regardless of barricade presence, all areas remain available to bike and pedestrian access. Project is entirely Pack It In Pack It Out with four boat ramp locations having dumpsters. All grounds and facility cleaning services are provided by uniformed NRM (ranger) personnel with volunteer support (Corps team is only two of three positions strong and lack boat operator licenses due to cancelled trainings). All restrooms are dry - none are waterborne. Unlocked vault toilets are posted that cleanings and disinfection occurs once per day and encourages the use of a personal supply of 60% alcohol hand sanitizer. Locked vault toilets have posted information of nearest open vault toilet. Supplemental law enforcement contract services with Ada County and Boise County began 23 May. Commander 12(a) restriction rescinded 15 June.
